## Amenity Grant Scheme 2024 Clonmel Borough District area - Guidelines

## 1. Scope of Scheme

The Clonmel Borough District Amenity Grants Scheme is formulated to assist residents associations in carrying out maintenance and development of open spaces in housing estates.

The types of activities which may qualify include:-

- Landscaping and development of open spaces.
- Provision or improvement of litter bins and street furniture.

#### 2. Restrictions and Drawdown

Drawdown of any grant awarded will only issue provided the request is in compliance with the following:-

- Grant assistance is only payable on foot of bona fide receipts provided by persons/companies <u>registered for VAT</u> and who can demonstrate tax compliance by way of production of a <u>tax clearance certificate</u> issued by the Revenue Commissioners.
- Copy of all receipts on suppliers headed paper showing dates and details of goods/services provided
- The grant awarded cannot be reassigned by you to another project or Resident Association
- No invoice/receipt = no grant payment

We would strongly encourage groups to be signed up to the Public Participation Network (PPN) and also link in with your local tidy towns group. This will help sustain and maintain your group in to the future by way of inclusion, participation and communication with other stakeholders.

### 3. Timescale for Drawdown

Any grant awarded must be drawn down by 31st October, 2024

Receipt of funding in previous years is no guarantee of funding in 2024. Likewise, allocation of funding in 2024 is no guarantee of funding in future years.
