5.1 Notice of Motion in the name of Councillor Jim Ryan - ID 2810

I am calling on this District to install traffic calming measures in Gortnahoe village as a matter of urgency due to the high level of daily speeding traffic passing through it particularly at the school.

Reply to NOM:

In the past 8 years there has been substantial intervention from the Thurles MD to address pedestrian safety and speed reduction measures in the village of Gortnahoe. For example:

installation of slipform kerbing to tighten carriageway and junction widths,

installation of a controlled pedestrian crossing,

installation of railing to the front of the school,

Installation and widening of footpaths in the area,

Installation of driver speed signs entering the village,

Installation of lining and signage for pedestrian and vehicular management.

It is proposed to carry out a speed survey to access the extent of driver non-compliance within the 50kph speed limit and based on this assessment we will consider applying allowable options as per the Traffic Management Guidance on Vertical Deflections subject to funding. We have also met recently with School Reps in this regard.

In the interim we will notify An Garda Siochana of reported speeding in the area especially around school collection and drop off and seek their feedback on the matter.
