

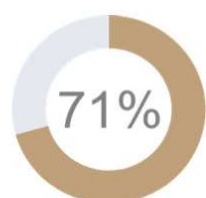

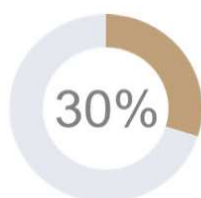


1,559 people from across the island of Ireland and around the world took part in the survey

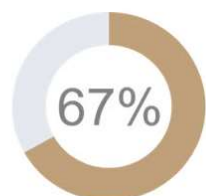
### Familiarity with Royal Sites



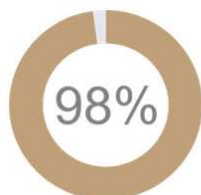
had **visited** the Royal Site closest to where they live



were **aware of all six** Royal Sites



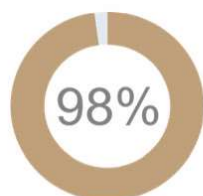
had visited **more than one** Royal Site

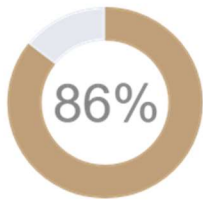

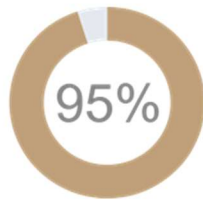

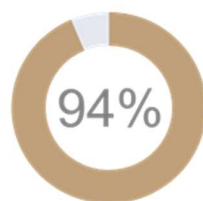
## UNESCO World Heritage Status



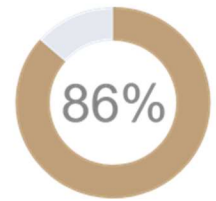
are **familiar** with existing **UNESCO World Heritage Sites**

**support inclusion** of the Royal Sites of Ireland on the new **Tentative List of UNESCO World Heritage Sites**

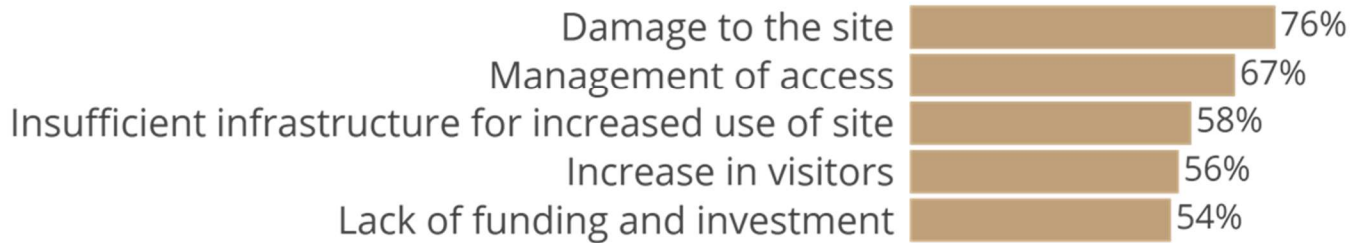


are **more likely to recommend a visit** to a Royal Site if it was on the **UNESCO World Heritage List**
