Consultation Services for Cruinniú na nÓg 2025

Objective:

To carry out a comprehensive consultation process with children and young people across County Tipperary in Autumn 2024. This consultation shall produce a report with recommendations which will help shape the **Tipperary Cruinniú na nÓg programme 2025**.

Background

Cruinniú na nÓg is a national day of free creativity for children and young people aged 18 yrs old and under. **Cruinniú na nÓg** is a flagship initiative of the **Creative Ireland Programme's Creative Youth Plan** to enable the creative potential of children and young people. The right of the child/young person to be heard is enshrined in Article 12 of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child.

Process

We are seeking applications from individuals, groups and/or organizations experienced in facilitating public engagement consultation with children and young people. This consultation may include delivering creative activities and workshops. We would like to hear from young people about the type of creative activities/projects that they would like to see programmed for **Cruinniú na nÓg 2025**. We also seek to gauge the overall visibility/impact of the **Cruinniú na nÓg** programme and receive a broad range of perspectives from different backgrounds, age groups, locations across County Tipperary. This could include children and young people who are in the international protection system/ temporary protection system, children/young people living in designated areas of disadvantage (Pobal), children/young people who are disabled, children/young people experiencing marginalisation, children in the traveller community etc.

The following should be addressed in your proposal.

- How many children will be facilitated and the involvement of seldom heard children and young people
- How do you plan to invite children and young people to the consultation and include them in the decision making process.
- Evaluation of data.
- Reporting.

Once the consultation process has taken place, **the final report should be submitted by Friday 13th December 2024.**

Budget

The budget for the project is up to €5,000 - this will include fees, travel & expenses, consultation development, preparation, delivery and reporting.

Individuals/organisations will be required to have public liability insurance and Garda Vetting will be completed.

1. Detailed proposal
2. CV, including two referees.
3. An example of a consultation with children/young people that you have previously devised and delivered.
4. Child protection policy

Deadline for submissions is 4pm on Wednesday 18th September 2024.
